Mile High Station

Would have a bar guarantee of \$12,000

BYOB would not be an option

Exdo

Would be available March 4 for a \$10,000 bar guarantee

If we didn't make the bar guarantee the difference would have to come from the Denver

Regional Fund

We could increase our size to 1,000 people

BYOB would not be an option

Smaller parking lot in back is available

Outside space could be quiet space, inside would be loud space

Fire performers could have small sound (no DJ) for performances

Would still need fire permit to be an official BM event

Meg informs the group that the city of Denver is looking into BYOB laws, and they may change drastically in the near future

No matter the venue, BYOB may not be an option in the future

Having Exdo as venue brings up the discussion of what we want CBE to be

We want fire art/performances
Decorating the space will be a very large job
We could lift any capacity cap – Exdo limit is 2000 and we are unlikely to hit that
Money not spent on Porta-potties and venue rental could be put toward deco and/or art grants
Bob recommends creating a mission statement that addresses people bringing art to serve as deco
More live art – painting, building, etc.
More live music
Talent show atmosphere?
 Could have time set aside for free-form acts/open mic
 Wardrobe Malfunction fashion show
 Story Portal?
 Dong Gong Show?

What would we like to ask Exdo for?

Tear down on Sunday instead of right after the event
Could we treat the parking lot as a separate event so people could BYOB and have food
Can we bring art cars inside?

Steve, Jen, Meg and Bob will handle negotiations and venue contract

Because we have a bar guarantee to cover, Steve suggests keeping tickets at a low cost - ~\$15

Could add pricing tiers in which people could give additional funds for art at CBE 2018

Bob brings up the point that we didn't give away all of our art budget at DeComp, so we are not in need of additional funds

Steve would like to use the tiers as incentive for people to buy early, but would like to see the extra funds that latecomers spend go to a cause

Meg motions for ticket and budgeting leads to make decisions on their own and come back to the group with final decisions
