Production time is 20 days, so we need to vote now

Craig motions to go with the universal tools as gifts

Matt seconds

Unanimous vote to approve universal tool with logo imprint as gifts

Oustide Stage

Asking \$1000 for basic setup such as a wedding-style tent

Tent is too expensive (would be over \$1000 for rental and setup)

Craig asked if the Guild project could be used to decorate the outside stage

Steve says no – we cannot volunteer other people's art, and they are already contributing a lot of art

Grant will go back to Milk and GloBus to see if anyone is interested/would they donate equipment

Art cars do not want to bring outside sound because they don't want to play under sound restrictions

Brûlée could bring their cages to help decorate

Grant will come back with more specific numbers as far as what they need to create an outdoor stage

We have \$300 allocated for sound, but no more for stage

Grant and Schmid-E could maybe build a stage with extra money

Grant moves for an additional \$300 for a total of \$600 to go to speakers and decks

Andrew is constructing the inside stage with a \$1000 grant
