Discussion

- High Importance
 - Still waiting on venue contract
 - Need to discuss recompense if they back out / sell venue before event
 - Still need fire permits
- Space / Placement
 - Still waiting on confirmation of usage of indoor space (occupancy permit only applies to indoor space)
 - Could also have Bad Asstronauts Portal as a covered space outdoors
 - Idea: sectioning off "garage-like" spaces for different sound camps
 - Can block off half of space depending on ticket sales and # of structures & art cars
 - Can make this kind of decision down the road (Aug?)
 - Although there are commitments, concerns about getting enough art
 - Need to continuously outreach
 - Can't have art cars driving around no moving cars
- Sound
 - Will want both stages going on at a minimum at least
 - Idea to partner with local silent disco company remain outdoors for as long as we want
 - Last year was \$300 in budget. Now that we have outdoor sound, this will go up
- DRF Support
 - Need to develop proposal on what resources we'll need in advance
 - Ex. Fox St needs \$20k bar guarantee via cashier's check (hold of ticket sales)
 - Convo happening Mon June 25 more details to come
- Gate
 - Two options including a 50 ft fire lane
 - Need to hire security team that has the liability insurance to check IDs
 - Fox St. has their own people serving alcohol
 - Security Fri night and Sat. and maybe Sun, if we have the budget
 - People can take stuff home on Sun or Mon night
- Volunteer Party
 - Fri / Sat set up
 - This can tie into the \$20k bar guarantee

Notable Historical Information

- Historically we get ½ or more of tickets sold the day of
- Last year, ~1350 people attended

Action items

- Sound Lead team to get together and discuss how we want different stages and budget proposal to come to next meeting with decisions so we can get the map developed
- Need fire permit
- Need group insurance
- Need site plan from venue
- Need some remaining Lead positions

- Infrastructure, Ticketing, LNT, Decor, Volunteer Party Planning, Graphics / Website, Greeters, Pleasers
- Develop Event Page
 - Collect Theme ideas via Facebook poll
 - "Robot Graveyard"
 - Make call out for remaining Lead positions
- Outreach for art installations etc.
 - Need to budget for art grants (transport, etc.)
