- ++ indicates that this sentiment was mentioned several times
 - ++ Lots of big art and things that were on playa, very "play-esque", interactive art, climbing stuff
 - Lots of new people stepped up to volunteer, good vibe
 - ++ Indoor / outdoor space is clutch, if not necessary for structures, anchoring into ground versus weighed down "venue needs dirt"
 - Fire spinning
 - Live music
 - Loved venue
 - Loved talent
 - Lots of good organizational tools and technologies developed over the past couple of years for use with planning

Every Rose Has Its Thorn (aka Things that didn't 60 so well)

- ++ indicates that this sentiment was mentioned several times
 - No after Burn report last year and this needs to get done
 - Big last minute changes happened with venue (Exdo)
 - Contract wasn't solid or adhered to fully
 - Contact at Exdo got fired, so initial agreements were lost
 - Set Up / Tear Down times all changed and/or severely reduced
 - ++ Since Tear Down time was moved around, less volunteers showed up
 - Could no longer hold Friday night Volunteer Party at Exdo
 - No after-event meeting for resolution or apology
 - Permitting Lead said they did paperwork and then, disappeared
 - More space than art, could've been filled up more, though outdoor placement was good overall

- Venue overcharged on bar tabs
- ++ Interruption during set up to go get wristbanded was major disruption
 - o Resolution: Set up crew should get wristbanded ahead of time
- ++ Major ticketing issues at event opening immediately after everyone was asked to gather Ticketfly issue
 - o Resolution: Make Ticketfly door cut off time, the day before
- "Less festival-y, more like Burning Man"
 - o Resolution: More stages, more variety of music
- Dueling outside sound systems ("Art Car Bus Stop got shafted" was cool they came sans grant)
- Couldn't use your own cup at bar (causes waste)
 - Resolution: Bring this up during contract process
- More light needed at workshops, hard to see for crafting work
- Volunteer Appreciation Party on Friday night before causes hungover volunteers on Sat. Questions as to why appreciation is celebrated before the work is performed.
 - Resolution: Schedule Volunteer Party after the event (potentially in conjunction with the Wrap Up Meeting)
- Ticketing Lead & Gate Lead & Volunteer Coordinator need to be communicating day of
 - Resolution: All need to have and use radios
- "It's like herding cats with fire performers" i.e. they don't usually start on time, but DJs do start on time. Caused issues with music not being available for later performers.
 - o Resolution: Should be coordinated better, remind DJs of this and that times should be flexible-ish
- Placement of fire performers green room was hinderance, had to walk through crowd with large implements
