Infrastructure

- All site services need to come on Fri night (including security & fencing)
- Get all your shit out by Sunday night leave at your own risk

Venue

- Do they allow bikes? What does our insurance say?
- Do venue lights work at night? No flood lights at venue
- Overnight security on Fri and Sat night, but not on Sun night. They have 6 ppl on site at the event
- Porta potties just need 20
- Who is the fencing company? Patrick wants to be there when they arrive

- Food trucks & around the fire barricade
- Can get trash fence from home depot and use tinder blocks from Patrick
- Or use plastic cones and caution tape or nylon rope
- Who's in charge of being around when things are being broken down? Steve Mena
- Current radio count is at 31, send Steve Mena

Lighting

- Need a plan for lighting, especially for Friday night, Medical, Rangers, Workshops, Storage
- Where do we want signs? We can give 45 signs from the sign camp pop up need to schedule volunteers for Friday night
- Lighting budget is is \$300
- Need some lighting towards the stage June does have access to some spotlights
- We have lighting for the sound stages
- Need lighting for storage
- Every dept that needs to take care of their own lighting

Signage

- We're making signs morning of Sunday
- Devin will get the stuff from Steve Maruska
- Add your custom sign needs spreadsheet.

Tickets

- 760 sold, but not all volunteer tix have been sold yet
- What is the plan for door sales?
- Set up crew should get wristbanded ahead of time
- Make Give Back Tickets door cut off time the day before Talk to Lea about this
- Pick a beneficiary to give a portion of our proceeds to on the givebacktickets.com website
- Ins and Outs will be searched again and wristband checked by security for the food trucks
- Security checking IDs and will not allow underage or intoxicated (First Response Security very familiar with this venue)
- Needs a small generator and tables & chairs

Volunteers

- Shifts are about 3/3 full blast this out to your people Gate & Radio is low Sun teardown is low
- They need a carport from Liz needs to go on Infrastructure spreadsheet

Sound

- Preference is that you set up all your stuff up on Friday night or early Sat morning let everyone know
- We need the generators Friday night
- We need a second genny needs a towable 2500 5000
- Should think about an acoustic sound stage
- Checks will be given out the day of the event invoices needed ahead of time
- Noise ordinance people talking on the side might
- DJs are being announced on Oct 10
- Stages are underneath the bus awnings, possibly only 1 4500 watt generator, 2 100ft cables
- Buses will be run down the middle for a sound buffer, Sante will bring his bus
- Need covers for the extension cords

Performance

- All artists and performers should get notified by their Leads about the event time change
- LAST YEAR: "It's like herding cats with fire performers" i.e. they don't usually start on time, but DJs do start on time. Caused issues with music not being available for later performers.
 - *Resolution:* Should be coordinated better, remind DJs of this and that times should be flexible-ish -TIMES NEED TO BE TIGHT
- LAST YEAR: Placement of fire performers green room was hinderance, had to walk through crowd with large implements
- 68 performers aerial stage

Workshops

Volunteer Appreciation Party

- This does still tie into our bar guarantee, right? Yes, still need a bar set up that night.
 - Liquor permit needs to be changed to that night as well

Food Trucks

- Pull a temporary soft street closure Sante?
 - Maybe, if not, need cones that we need source.

Medical

- Power situation run off the generators from the stages? And whatever back up. Bring extension cords.
- Small generator under 5000 watts is being brought by Bad Asstronauts for the Medical, need covers and extension cords.
